



ADVANCED STANDING AND TRANSCRIPTED CREDIT

Did you know you can earn college credits while in high school? The more college credits you earn in high school, the closer you will be to earning your college degree. Some students who plan carefully may even complete a college degree or diploma while still in high school. This valuable opportunity gives you a head start on your degree while saving you time and money.

START COLLEGE NOW

If you're a qualifying junior or senior in high school, you can take college courses at a Wisconsin technical college. Approved courses count toward high school graduation and college credit.

YOUTH Apprenticeship

These are your credits to transfer whenever and wherever you want to go in your education or career.

Wisconsin's technical colleges offer a variety of certificates and degrees that build on each other, giving you more options for progressing at your own pace. You can move between institutions to gain additional credentials or degrees and improve your career potential.



TRANSFER CREDITS INTO A TECHNICAL COLLEGE

If you have previously attended another college or university, you may be able to transfer credits, receive existing credits or earn new credits for skills and knowledge you gained at that college. Wisconsin's technical colleges also grant college credit for career-related learning, work experience and military service.

TRANSFER CREDITS INTO A UNIVERSITY (program-specific or university transfer)

All 16 technical colleges have programspecific transfer agreements with four-year private colleges and universities, including the Universities of Wisconsin. Many transfer agreements also transfer to colleges and universities in other states.

All of Wisconsin's technical colleges also offer an Associate of Arts or Science degree (also called University Transfer). If eligible, you'll receive junior status when transferring into a college at the Universities of Wisconsin.

You should verify your credit transfer status with both institutions to ensure you will qualify.



PROMISE PROGRAMS & OTHER SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Many of Wisconsin's technical colleges are making college possible for qualified, low-income students in their respective technical college districts. Promise programs are funded privately through relationships with local partners. These programs allow new high school graduates — who otherwise may be unable to attend technical college because of low family income — to earn a degree tuition-free. Check with your technical college of choice to see if it offers these opportunities.

FINANCIAL AID

Students seeking financial aid should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA determines whether you can receive state and/or federal funding. You will only know if you are eligible for financial aid if you apply. It's well worth the effort.

There are some helpful resources from the U.S. Dept. of Education at **fafsa.gov.** You can also contact the college's financial aid department to confirm due dates, ask questions, etc. The FAFSA application cycle occurs from October 1 through June 30. Since aid is awarded on a first come, first serve basis, please complete the FAFSA as soon as possible to improve your chances of receiving aid.

COLLEGE GOAL WISCONSIN EVENTS

College Goal volunteers help students and their families complete financial aid application forms, including the FAFSA. Between November and January, there are typically over 30 events across the state. Learn more at **collegegoalwi.org.**

SHARED PROGRAMS

To provide more program options, a college may collaborate on (or share) a program with another college, offering some classes at each institution. Students seeking financial aid must apply at the degree-granting college that will process and pay the financial aid.
